

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR SHEET METAL WORKERS' PENSION PLAN OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, ARIZONA & NEVADA

This is a summary of the annual report of the Sheet Metal Workers' Pension Plan of Southern California, Arizona & Nevada, Employer Identification Number 95-6052257, a multiple-employer-collectively bargained Plan for the year ended December 31, 2000. The annual report has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits of the Plan are provided by employers' contributions. Plan expenses were \$48,949,340. These expenses included \$4,233,242 in administrative expenses and \$44,716,098 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 9,110 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the Plan at the end of the Plan year, although not all these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets after subtracting liabilities of the Plan, was \$921,527,896 as of December 31, 2000 compared to \$936,537,587 as of December 31, 1999. During the plan year, the Plan experienced decrease in its net assets of \$(15,009,691). This decrease is the difference between the value of Plan's assets as of December 31, 2000 and the value of the assets as of December 31, 1999 or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The Plan had total income of \$33,939,649 including employer contributions of \$19,116,222, gains from sale of assets of \$38,330,487, earnings from investments of \$36,192,950, unrealized depreciation on investments of \$60,400,885 and other income of \$700,875.

The Plan had total income of \$33,939,649 including employer contributions of \$19,116,222, gains from sale of assets of \$38,330,487, earnings from investments of \$36,192,950, unrealized depreciation on investments of \$60,400,885 and other income of \$700,875.
