

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
FOR
**SHEET METAL WORKERS' PENSION PLAN
OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, ARIZONA & NEVADA**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Sheet Metal Workers' Pension Plan of Southern California, Arizona & Nevada, Employer Identification Number 95-6052257, Plan Number 001, for the period January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2001. The annual report has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA").

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the Plan are provided by general assets of the sponsor. Total plan expenses were \$55,730,384. These expenses included \$4,235,713 in administrative expenses and \$51,494,671 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$0 in other expenses. A total of 9,264 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the Plan at the end of the Plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets after subtracting liabilities of the Plan, was \$872,635,383 as of December 31, 2001 compared to \$936,527,896 as of December 31, 2000. During the plan year, the Plan experienced a change in its net assets of \$-48,892,513. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the Plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the costs of assets acquired during the year. The Plan had total income of \$6,837,871 which included employer contributions of \$18,938,873, employee contributions of \$0, gain/loss of \$-14,302,108 from the sale of assets and earnings from investments of \$1,814,290.

Minimum Funding Standards

An actuary's statement shows that enough money was contributed to the Plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.

- (b) financial information and information on payments to service providers

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as a part of the report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.
